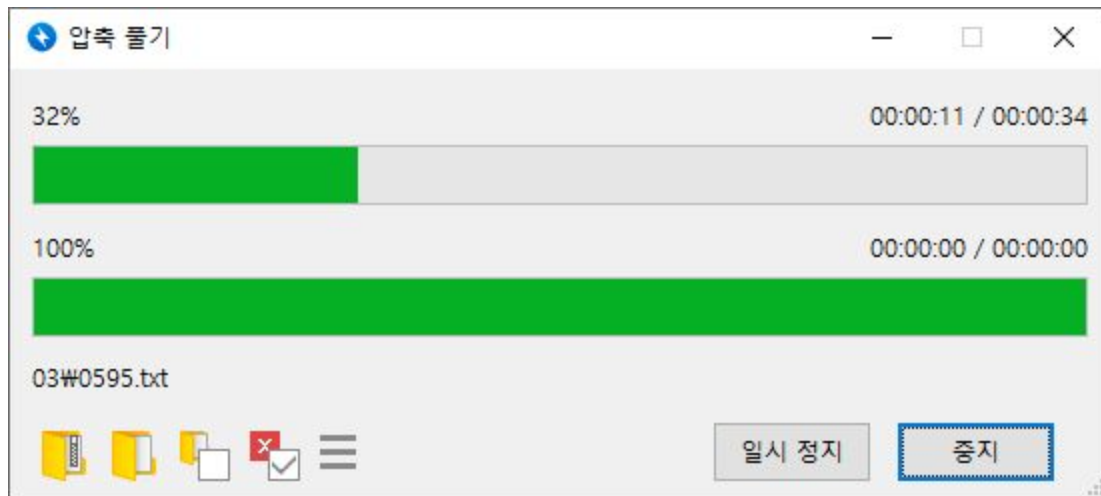


How to reproduce the issue

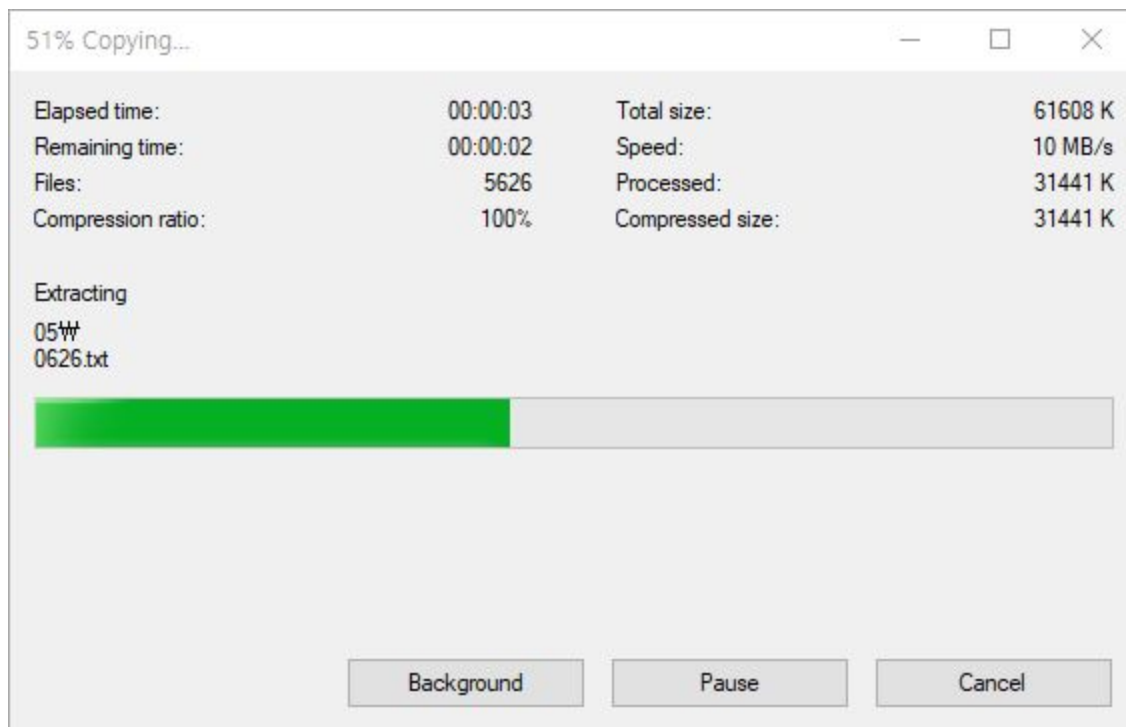
1) Please download the sample file below.

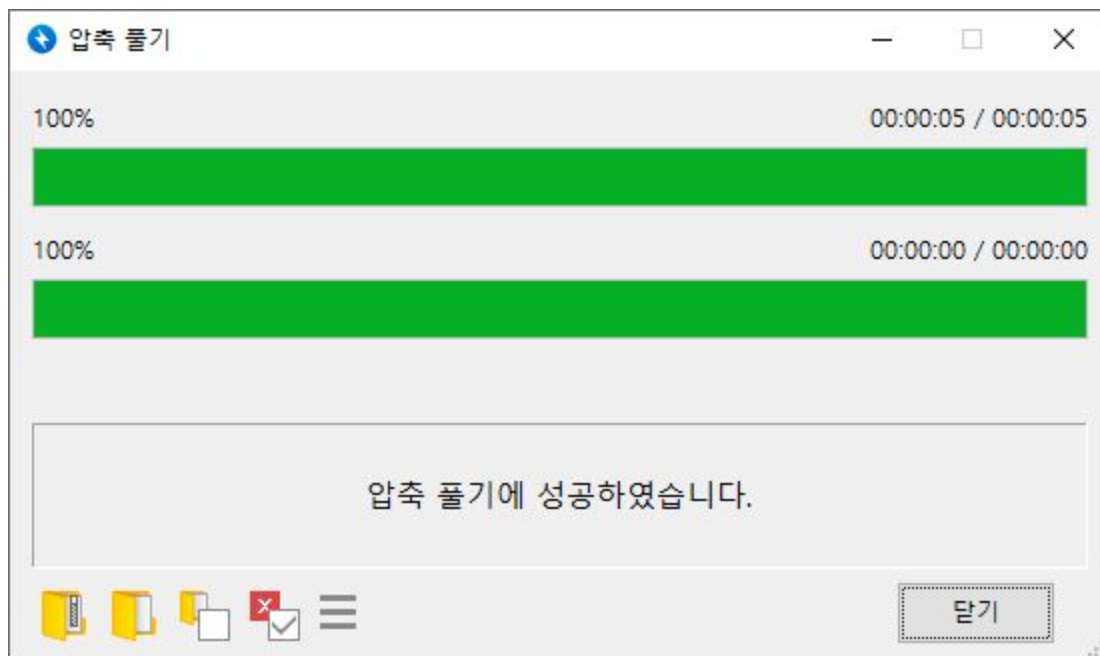
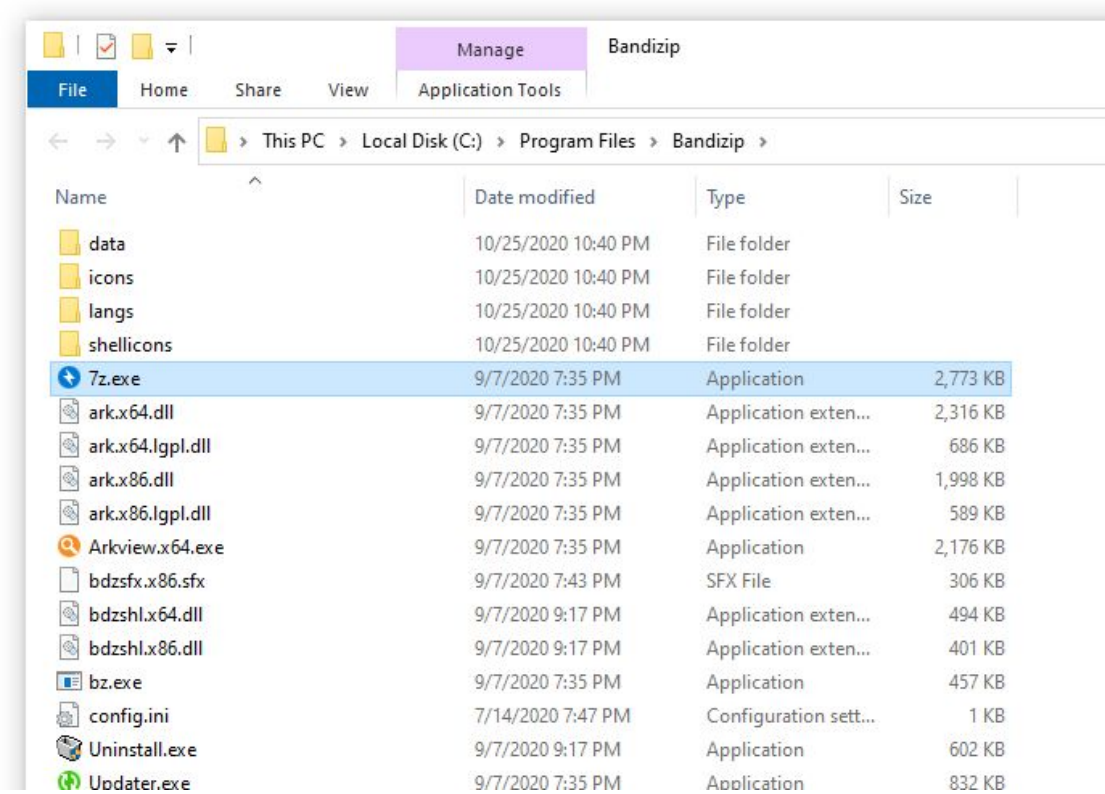
2) Decompression with Bandizip takes more than 30 secs.



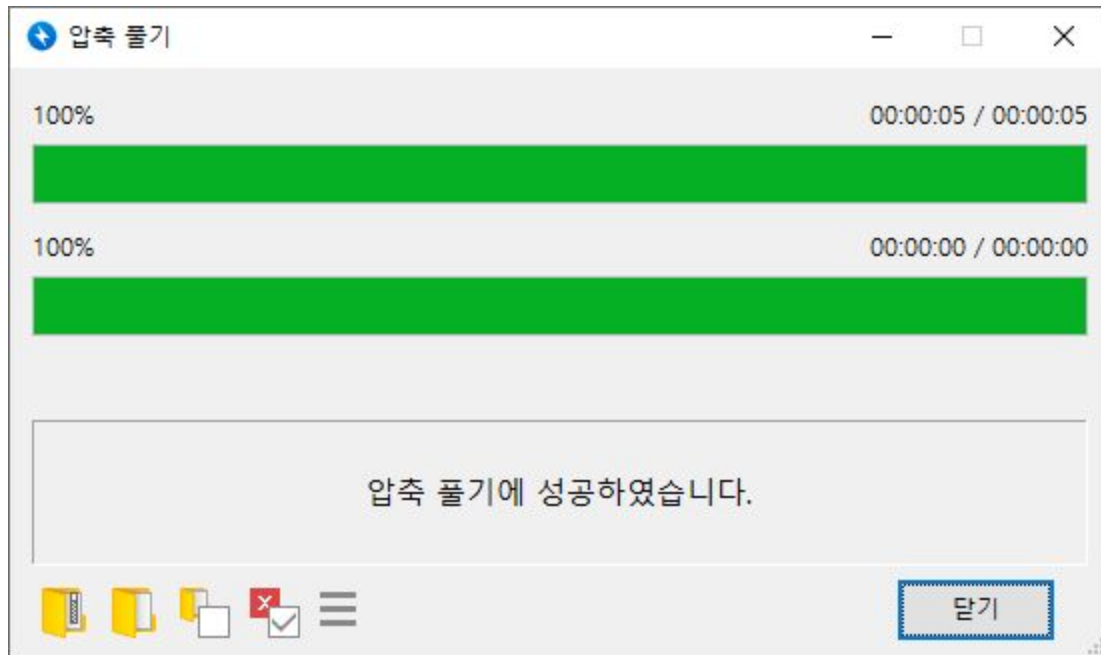
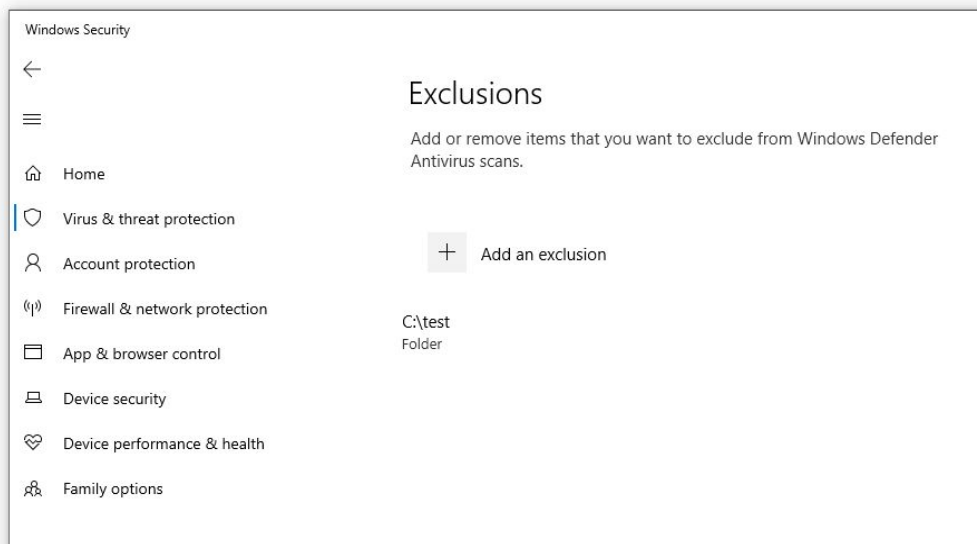
3) Decompression with 7-Zip takes about 5 secs.



4) After renaming Bandizip.exe to 7z.exe, decompression using Bandizip takes about 5 secs.



5) After adding "c:\test" to the Defender's exclusion list, decompression (using Bandizip) to c:\test takes about 5 secs.



Judging from the things, we believe that Windows Defender has a separate exclusion list for archiving software such as 7z.exe. We are asking Microsoft to add Bandizip ("Bandizip.exe" and "bz.exe") to the default exclusion list for the Defender's AV scan since the archiver is widely and commonly used in Korea and the rest of the world.
